


Remove and install the parts as shown.



(MAIN POINTS OF REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION)

NOTICE: When supplementing the power steering fluid, use TOYOTA POWER STEERING FLUID EH or equivalent which is exclusively for EHPS use.

HINT: The power steering pump is not to be disasse—mbled, so if a malfunction occurs, replace it as an assembly.



1. DISCONNECT AND CONNECT PRESSURE LINE

Using SST, disconnect and connect the pressure line. SST 09631– 22020

Torque: 36 N-m (370 kgf-cm, 27 ft-lbf)

HINT: When connecting, use a torque wrench with a fulcrum length of 300 mm (111.81 in.).
