

# LOWER SUSPENSION ARM COMPONENTS






## LOWER ARM REMOVAL


- 1. JACK UP VEHICLE AND REMOVE REAR WHEEL
- 2. DISCONNECT LOWER ARM FROM BALL JOINT
- (a) Remove the cotter pin and nut.
- (b) Using SST, disconnect the lower arm from the ball joint.
  - SST 09628-62011

## 3. REMOVE STRUT BAR NUT AND RETAINER

Remove the strut bar nut and retainer from the lower arm.








#### 4. REMOVE LOWER ARM

- (a) Remove the bolt holding the lower arm to the body and remove the lower arm.
- (b) Remove the strut bar cushions, collar and retainer from the lower arm.




# LOWER ARM INSTALLATION


- 1. INSTALL LOWER ARM
- (a) Install the strut bar retainer, cushions, and collar to the strut bar.

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- (b) Connect the lower arm to the strut bar.
- (c) Temporarily install a new strut bar nut.



(d) Install the lower arm to the body. Do not torque the bolt.




#### 2. CONNECT LOWER ARM TO BALL JOINT

- (a) Connect the lower arm to the ball joint.
- (b) Install the nut.


Torque: 91 N-m (930 kgf-cm, 67 ft-lbf)

(c) Install a new cotter pin.



### **3. STABILIZE SUSPENSION**


- (a) Install the rear wheel and lower vehicle. Torque: 103 N-m (1,050 kgf-cm, 76 ft-lbf)
- (b) Bounce the vehicle up and down several times to allow the suspension to settle.



### 4. TORQUE LOWER ARM HOLDING NUT

(a) Torque the strut bar nut with the vehicle load applied on the suspension.

Torque: 118 N-m (1,200 kgf.cm, 87 ft.lbf)



(b) Torque the lower arm holding nut with the vehicle load applied on the suspension.
Torque: 103 N-m (1,050 kgf-cm. 76 ft-lbf)
5. CHECK REAR WHEEL ALIGNMENT
